Helen E. Fisher, PhD is a Research Professor in the Department of Anthropology at Rutgers University. Helen is widely known for her books about the evolution of human love and sexuality. She serves as chief scientific advisor to the dating site Chemistry.com, a division of Match.com, which she has used to develop a scientific database of mate choice and romantic behavior. She is a frequent guest on television shows such as 20/20 and The View.

Dr. Fisher has written five books on the evolution and future of human sexuality, monogamy, adultery and divorce, gender differences in the brain, the chemistry of romantic love, and most recently, human personality types and why we fall in love with one person rather than another.
